

**SCHEDULE 3****Part 1****TECHNICAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS****A. TECHNICAL SUBMISSION**

The Technical Submission shall provide sufficient information to reasonably demonstrate that the Proponent can meet the responsibilities and obligations of the Proponent as set out in the Project Agreement. In preparing its Technical Submission, the Proponent is encouraged to cite past project experience of a similar nature, including how it and its Proponent Team Members:

- resolved issues;
- addressed counterparty concerns; and
- would apply any lessons learned to the Project.

**B. TECHNICAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

1. The Technical Submission shall conform to the requirements outlined in the “Proposal Submission” column of the tables found in Exhibit A of Schedule 2 and conform to the page count requirements found in Exhibit B of Schedule 2.
2. The Technical Submission will be graded according to the “assignment of points” table found in Exhibit A of Schedule 2.

**C. ADDITIONAL TECHNICAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS – VEHICLE OPTIONS**

If the Proponent is also making a 16 Vehicle Submission, at the end of each applicable section (B1 through B6) of the Proponent’s Technical Submission, the Proponent shall provide, on a separate page(s) (no page limit) any incremental changes to such Technical Submission section resulting from an increase in size of the initial fleet of Vehicles from 14 Vehicles to 16 Vehicles (the “**Vehicle Incremental Changes (Technical)**”). The top of each page shall be clearly labelled “**Vehicle Incremental Changes (Technical)**”.
